
Policy Priorities

Analysis of 16,257 responses, calculated by word frequency counts and clustered by thematic issues.



Health and Reproductive Rights

Access to affordable health care, including reproductive care (including abortion), was the dominant set of policy concerns of respondents. 1 in every 3 priority issues reported were related to health.

Economic Justice

A cluster of policy issues related to economic justice such as equal pay, social safety nets, union organizing and access to quality jobs - were the next highest priorities.

Climate and Environment

Just over 1 in 10 policy priorities identified were related to protecting the environment and dealing with climate change.

LGBTQ+ Equality

LGBTQ+ equality, while important, is not the primary political or policy priority of most respondents: a wider range of issues related to survival are the concerns mos widely shared.

Racial Justice and related issues

Racial Justice (7.1%) including dealing with systemic racism and white supremacy; Criminal Justice (4.5%) including police violence and the prison reform/abolishment; and Civil Rights (4.3 %) including voting rights.

Gun Control

Gun control was one of the largest 'stand alone' policy issues identified by respondents as an action priority,

Women's Rights

"Women's Rights" were not identified as stand alone policy priorities. When raised they focused on equarights, including pay and economic opportunity.
